



September polio vaccination clinics in Lewisham

Children aged **1 to 9 years** old in London are being offered a dose of polio vaccine. For some children this may be an extra dose on top of their routine vaccinations. In other children it may bring them up to date with their routine vaccinations.

There are signs the virus may be spreading in London and the number of children vaccinated is lower than it should be. Boosting immunity in children should help protect them and reduce the risk of the virus continuing to spread in Lewisham and beyond.



Clinics are between 8am and 5pm on Mondays, Fridays, and Saturdays in September.
